Domestic Disturbance leads to search warrant and drug charges

Smyrna Police Officers seized a large amount of marijuana and assorted drug paraphernalia after executing a search warrant on a local residence. On 3/12/16 at approx. 1042 hrs, SPD officers responded to the 300 block of Braddock Rd for a reported domestic disturbance. Upon arrival to the area, an SPD officer stopped the male half of the disturbance, later identified as Emory Monroe, 51, of Smyrna. During investigation, Mr. Monroe was found to be in possession of approx. 50 grams of marijuana. Other SPD officers arrived at the residence and made contact with Genevia Wiltbank, 38, of Smyrna. Investigation at the residence led Officers to seek and obtain a search and seizure warrant. This warrant was executed with the assistance of an SPD K9 team. Inside of the residence Officers located an additional 200 grams (nearly ½ pound) of marijuana as well as digital scales and other assorted paraphernalia. Both Mr Monroe and Ms Wiltbank were transported to SPD where they were charged with Possession of Marijuana other than personal use quantity, Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Both Suspects were arraigned via video court in JP #7. Both Suspects were released on unsecured bond pending a future court hearing.
