

### TEN-DIGIT DIALING



Ten-digit dialing is coming to Delaware this year. You'll need to add (302) to all Delaware calls!

Beginning April 24, 2021, telephone users in Delaware with Delaware phone numbers (area code 302) will begin to dial local numbers using the full 10-digit phone numbers. Beginning October 24, 2021 ALL local calls must be dialed using the full 10-digit telephone number.

What do I need to do?

If you have numbers stored in your home, mobile, or company phones, you will have to ensure that they are programmed to use the full 10 digit phone number during the "permissive dialing" period beginning April 24, 2021. Businesses that have on-site phone systems may have to change dialing rules in those systems. These changes must be completed prior to the mandatory 10-digit dialing implementation date of October 24, 2021.


