


Town of Smyrna offices will be closed on Monday, January 17th in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day. We will reopen on Tuesday, January 18th.



## PACKING AN EMERGENCY KIT

WINTER SAFETY GUIDE

**40%** of American drivers do  
not carry an emergency  
kit in their vehicle.

Always keep an emergency kit handy  
and in winter, make sure to include:

- 1 First-aid kit
- 2 Flashlight with extra batteries
- 3 Rags, paper towels or pre-moistened wipes
- 4 Drinking water/snacks for everyone in the car (including pets)
- 5 Warm gloves, clothes, hats and blankets
- 6 Basic toolkit including duct tape and warning devices (such as flares or reflective triangles)
- 7 Ice scraper/snow brush
- 8 Jumper cables/jump pack
- 9 Traction aids (sand/salt/non-clumping cat litter)
- 10 Mobile phone and car charger
- 11 Winter windshield washer solvent
- 12 Tarp, raincoat and gloves
- 13 Shovel
