SENIOR CITIZEN TAX EXEMPTIONS


The Town of Smyrna is offering eligible citizens age 65 and over exemption from the first \$30,000.00 of property tax assessment provided that their 2020 calendar year household income from all sources except Social Security, Veteran Disability

You can apply online or print the application can be obtained at the link below. If you have any questions please call the tax department at 302-389-2315.

Compensation, and Railroad Pension did not exceed \$24,000.00 for an individual applicant or \$30,000.00 for applicants filing jointly and that said applicants live in said dwelling for which exemption is claimed consecutively for at least one (1) year immediately prior to May 1, 2021. Applicants must provide proof of age and income.

Completed applications must be returned to the Town Hall no later than March 19, 2021 to be considered.

Starting Monday, April 5th
The town recently acquired a rear-loading trash truck to improved collections and will re-purpose the previous blue and yellow recycling bins for a more efficient yard waste program. Only yard waste in a rigid container will be collected by the town.
The yard waste schedule will remain the same and can be

viewed [here](#). You do not need to call in to request a pick up.

There are two (2) ways to request a bin.

You can use our **online submission form** or request one from **Jennifer in Public Works**. If you email her, please use the subject line: residential yard waste bin request.

Already own a container? Great! You can use your personal container as long as it has a solid metal bar on the front for collection tipping and does not exceed 96-gallons. Please let Jennifer know that you will be using your personal bin. Yard Waste decals will be available at Town Hall at no cost. This decal must be applied to the container for it to be collected.
