YARD WASTE Q & A

1. What is the yard waste program?

The program is to help residents maintain their yards on a small scale; like the removal of grass clippings, trimmings, small fallen twigs/branches. This is not to supplement services like tree removal or major tree trimming.

2. Do I really need a container?

Yes. Request a bin from the Town of Smyrna OR use a personal container if it has a solid metal bar on the front for collection tipping and does not exceed 96-gallons.

3. Can I leave yard waste outside of the container?

No. The town has a rear-loading truck to improve collections. Everything has to be in the container for collection. You can use biodegradable bags if needed, and then place the yard waste in the container.

4. How often is yard waste collected?

Collection is weekly, Monday-Wednesday (excluding holidays), from early Spring to mid-Fall. The town is split into three (3) districts and the schedule and map can be viewed on the website.

5. Are all residents eligible for collection?

No. Yard waste collection is limited to residential homes where trash/recycling is also charged.


