Please make sure items left on the curb are out prior to 10/30. Anything placed at the curb after 10/30, will not be collected.

Everyday household items will be collected except for:

- Hazardous waste materials
 - o Paint, oil, medications, asbestos, full aerosol cans, cleaners, compressed gas, chemicals, perfumes, etc.
- Construction materials
 - o Insulation, shingles, concrete, lumber, etc.
- Tires
- Other similar items

- Only buses will proceed onto the JBM campus; cars will remain on-street.
- Parent drop-off, pick up will NOT happen from the South Street access.
- Parents will pick-up after 3:30 PM on campus, approaching from Frazier Street.




