DHSS is receiving reports of a new round of fraudulent scams involving text messages that appear to be related to vaccination validation. The new messages link to a fraudulent webpage with DHSS and DMV in the URL and asks for personal information. This text message is NOT legitimate and is NOT associated with DHSS or any other state agency.

As a reminder, DHSS will not ask for private information such as Social Security number or driver's license number through this means. If you receive such a message, do not respond, and report it to your law enforcement agency for investigation.


