A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE
ANNUAL HALLOWEEN CELEBRATION**

WHEREAS, it has been the custom for many years for children to celebrate the eve of All Saints Day by costuming, masquerading and fun making; and

WHEREAS, the Smyrna Town Council has a tradition of establishing the date and time for Trick-or-Treat for Halloween; and

WHEREAS, the Smyrna Town Council would like to maintain its tradition of setting the date and time for those who wish to participate in Halloween.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, the Town Council of the Town of Smyrna, does hereby request and urge the observance of this celebration as follows:

October 31st shall be the date for costuming, and the only time for tricks and treats with all celebrating being conducted between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that residents may indicate whether or not they wish to participate in Trick-or-Treat by turning their lights on or off; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that trick or treaters are to be respectful if a house has its lights turned off and not ring the doorbell; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all celebrants are urged not to commit acts of violence or destruction under penalty of the law.
