**AN ORDINANCE MAKING HOUSEKEEPING CHANGES TO
CHAPTER 66 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, Chapter 66 “Traffic and Vehicles” has been amended over the years to include various new provisions, which has resulted in re-numbering some of the existing provisions;

WHEREAS, some internal references to code sections and subsection titles found in Section 66-1(e) (“Traffic signs and signals”) were never revised to reflect the changes which have occurred; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council seeks to avoid confusion by correcting these errors;

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Smyrna, a majority thereof concurring in council duly met, that the town code be amended as follows:

Section 1. Amend Section 66-1(e) (“Traffic signs and signals”) by deleting subsection (e) in its entirety and inserting in its place thereof the following:

(e) Except for emergency regulations adopted pursuant to section 66-1(d) above, it shall be an affirmative defense to any charge brought under section 66-26 (Commercial Vehicles; Travel Over Certain Streets Prohibited), section 66-41 (One-Way Streets), section 66-51 (Signs, Signals, Markings and Devices), section 66-52 (Comply with Signs), section 66-66 (Speed Limits Established; Penalty), section 66-100 (Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours), section 66-101 (Parking Prohibited in Certain Areas at all Times), section 66-102 (Parking Prohibited for Longer than Certain Times in Certain Areas), section 66-103 (Parking in Fire Lanes), section 66-104 (Handicapped Parking and Signage for Persons with Disabilities), section 66-105 (Parking on Certain Streets During Snowfall), and section 66-106 (Parking Prohibited Except When Parallel), that an appropriate traffic control sign, signal, electronic device, and/or lane marking was not in place, properly operating, or otherwise incapable of placing a reasonable person on notice as to the prescribed conduct.

SYNOPSIS

This is a housekeeping ordinance that corrects various internal references and subsection titles found in Section 66-1(e) (“Traffic signs and signals”) to reflect the accurate references.
